## South Tyrol



*Small but beautiful: With just 5,200 hectares of vineyards, Italy's northernmost wine-growing region contributes around one percent to Italy's total production – 98 percent of which, however, are DOC wines. In addition to the native grape varieties Lagrein, Vernatsch and Gewürztraminer, Pinot Bianco, Pinot Grigio and Pinot Noir have been native for 150 years. The excellent cooperative wineries, which process 70 percent of the grapes, play a major role. The strengths of viticulture include the different structure of the soils, a mix of Alpine and Mediterranean climates and altitudes between 200 and 1,000 meters, which contribute to fresh and balanced wines.*

## Veneto



*Probably the most diverse region in Italy: surrounded by Lake Garda, the Dolomites, the Po Valley and the Adriatic coast, both white and red grape varieties thrive here. In addition to the indigenous grape varieties Corvina and Rondinella, the basis for Valpolicella and Amarone, Garganega and Turbiana for white wine, Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Cabernet and Merlot can also be found here. The white wines are fruity and fresh, while the red wines are long-lasting and juicy. The Ripasso method is well known. For this, young, fermented Valpolicella red wines are added to the Amarone marc. A second fermentation takes place, which increases the wine's alcohol content and colour.*

## Friuli



*The top region for white wine, even beyond Italy. Between the Alps and the Adriatic Sea, Slovenia and Veneto lies a landscape created partly by rolling hills and partly by the alluvial plains of large rivers. Clay and limestone soils, high temperature differences between day and night and a Mediterranean climate are the ideal conditions for growing white wine. The indigenous grape varieties Friulano and Ribolla Gialla are the region's flagship wines, as are Chardonnay, Sauvignon and Pinot Grigio.*

## Lombardy



*In addition to the light red and fresh white wines, the region is primarily famous for its elegant sparkling wines in Oltrepò Pavese and Franciacorta. In addition to Trebbiano for Lugana, the region is also home to Chardonnay and Nebbiolo. The area is characterised by both the cool mountain winds from the north and the influence of the Mediterranean from the south. The south-west shores of Lake Garda, the Franciacorta between Bergamo and Brescia and the calcareous and clayey soils of the Oltrepò are best suited to viticulture.*

## Piedmont



*One of the world's great wine-growing regions! It owes this above all to the wines of the Langhe and the Nebbiolo grape variety. In addition to this, which is synonymous with excellent Baroli and Barbareschi, the region also offers other grape varieties such as Barbera and Dolcetto as well as Cortese and Arneis among the white wines. The natural amphitheatre of the Alps, which borders the region on three sides, ensures a balanced climate without temperature excesses. The hilly areas with their clay-limestone soils, some with sandy components, benefit from this in particular.*

## Tuscany



*Probably the country's best-known region for top red wine. Located in central Italy around the capital Florence, the region stretches from the Ligurian coast in the north alongside Emilia Romagna and Umbria to Lazio in the south. The clay-limestone components with sandy sections mean that particularly elegant red wines mature into Supertuscans here. Almost everywhere, the Sangiovese grape is an important or even the only component of DOC and DOCG wines, with the exception of the coast, where French grape varieties such as Cabernet, Merlot and Syrah have gained a foothold.*

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## Marche



*The vineyards border the kilometres of white sandy beaches directly on the Adriatic Sea. The soils are characterised by both sandy and clayey subsoil. Fresh, mineral and very long-lasting wines are produced here from autochthonous white grape varieties such as Pecorino and Verdicchio. In addition to Montepulciano and Sangiovese, international grape varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot also dominate the red wines. The red wines are matured in a very compact and structured way.*

## Abruzzo



*Below the Marche, we head into Abruzzo: to the east, the long sandy beaches along the blue Adriatic Sea, to the west, the fertile green soils on the Gran Sasso and Majella ridges. Here there are multi-layered soils of clay and limestone with sandy components. Two climates - continental and Mediterranean - ensure strong temperature fluctuations between day and night, which supports good ventilation. This is the basis for elegant and, above all, long-lasting wines with enormous ageing potential. The vines are still traditionally grown on the Pergola Abruzzese, which is also becoming increasingly important for new plantings.*

## Umbria



*Located in central Italy, this region is characterised by its hilly, almost mountainous landscape. Although the area does not border a coast, a Mediterranean microclimate from Lake Trasimeno in the east and the Tiber Valley contributes to optimal ripening of the grapes. The soils here are also predominantly clayey and calcareous. Well-known autochthonous grape varieties are Grechetto and Sagrantino.*

## Puglia



*The region stretches from north to south on the "heel of the boot". A very dry and hot climate, little rainfall, plenty of ventilation and a soil structure of limestone, clay and sand produce particularly strong wines from the Negroamaro and Primitivo grape varieties. The latter comes from the autochthonous Croatian grape variety "Crljenak", which is also known as "Zinfandel" in California. Although it has been suspected for a long time, it was only at the end of the 1990s that scientists established the connection based on a DNA structure and thus proved the origin of the vine.*

## Sardinia



*We are here on the second largest island in Italy, characterised by vast mountain landscapes surrounded by white sandy beaches. The Mediterranean climate characterises the south, where predominantly autochthonous grape varieties are still rooted in the sand. Grapes from Carignano, Cannonau and Bovale predominate here, which are vinified into dark and powerful red wines. In the north and inland, the climate is more continental, which contributes to fresh white wines around the Vermentino variety.*

## Sicily



*High-quality wines have been produced in Sicily since the end of the 1980s. The introduction of the DOC Sicilia in 2012 guarantees a solid standard. The region is very diverse: between Mount Etna in the east and Pantelleria in the west, autochthonous grape varieties such as Nero d'Avola, Nero Mascalese and Inzolia thrive on sand next to the sea, clay and limestone soils and mineral basalt soils of volcanic origin inland. In the latter, wines are produced under the Etna DOC designation of origin, which are reminiscent of long-lasting, mineral northern wines due to the special Mediterranean, alpine-mineral climate and enormous temperature fluctuations between day and night.*
